

Catch up funding grant

The catch up funding grant for Broomfield School is £58320.

The following priorities have been identified

IT provision for pupils, teaching and pastoral resources. (£34,000)

- Provision of IT resources to pupils: To date we have supplied approx. 180 pupils with chrome books -103 of these have been supplied by the DFE, 32 were provided prior to catch up funding. We currently have 55 pupils waiting for next delivery of chrome book, pupils who are waiting and have no access to IT are having work posted home. Since September 2020 we have purchased 133 Chromebooks. We have provided WIFI for 10 pupils.
- Provision of IT resources for teaching, including upgrade of google classroom, , web cams , parents evening software etc.
- Provision of phones/SIMcards to pastoral staff to enable weekly pastoral checks with all pupils and more regular pastoral checks with vulnerable pupils.

Teacher withdrawal groups and tutoring (£16,000)

- Additional experienced English teacher (Andriana Nicholas) for one day per week for withdrawal of small groups of pupils for extended writing in English.
- NTP tutoring for identified PP pupils in groups of 1:3 for 15 hours per group
- NTP academic mentor from 1-2-21 until 31-7-21 (funded by DFE with school paying on-costs)
- TA led reading interventions

Support for EAL pupils. (£6000)

- Flash academy software and licences for home use
- Additional EAL teacher to support with EAL withdrawal lesson
- Whole school literacy programme

Other (£5000)

- Provision of breakfast for all pupils attending school during lockdown
- Additional p/t teacher to allow increased capacity for DSL
