Modern Languages Spanish Key Stage 3 Overview:

Years 7 to 9

In years 7 to 9, Broomfield pupils are taught Spanish. They learn how to construct sentences, read increasingly complex authentic passages, listen to native speakers, and speak Spanish with confidence.

Course

Pupils are fully prepared to take on the challenges of GCSE by the time they complete the course using Viva 1, Viva 2, and Viva 3. They are taught in designated language classrooms by experts in the subject. They have access to online material which supports them in their homework and provides them with additional grammar, listening and reading material. Pupils are expected to learn vocabulary and show their learning in a short test in class. They are also given written exercises to complete independently. Broomfield pupils really enjoy their Spanish lessons even if they were introduced to a different foreign language at primary school.

Assessment

Pupils are formally assessed three times per year. Pupils will be given some vocabulary support to prepare for assessments practice and they will enjoy making progress using these benchmarks. Assessments may feature content previously covered or some surprise elements that pupils must deduce, to prepare them for their examinations.

Grouping & Setting

In Year 7, pupils are placed into groups based on their progress in assessments and in class. These sets are reviewed each half term after end of unit tests.
